NIIT Bags Rs 84 Cr Order From Gujarat

Software training firm NIIT Ltd today said it has bagged a five-year contract worth Rs 84.38 crore from the Gujarat government for providing computer education in 1,870 schools in the state.

In a filing to the Bombay Stock Exchange, NIIT said it has bagged an order from the Department of Education, Government of Gujarat, to introduce 'Computer Aided Learning' in 1,870 high and higher secondary schools for 9-12 classes in Gujarat.

The contract would impact 9,00,000 students across Gujarat. Earlier, the firm had entered into a similar agreement with the Rajasthan government for providing computer education in 1,672 schools.
