Subject: TDS on Dividend Payment during the Financial Year 2023-24

Dear Shareholder,

Greetings from NIIT Ltd!!

We hope that you and your family are doing well and are safe and healthy.

We are pleased to inform you that the Board of Directors of your Company at its meeting held on **October 31, 2023**, has declared an **Interim Dividend of Rs. 0.50** per share for the Financial Year 2023-24. The said dividend as declared by the Board, will be payable to those shareholders whose names appear in the Register of Members of the company or in the records of the Depositories as beneficial owners of the shares as at the close of business hours on **November 10, 2023 (Record Date)**.

In accordance with the provisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961 (the "Act") as amended by the Finance Act, 2020, dividend declared and paid by a company shall be taxable in the hands of the shareholders. Further the Company is required to deduct tax at source (TDS) from dividend paid to the shareholders at the applicable rates as per the provisions of the Act. We shall therefore be required to deduct tax at source (TDS) at the time of making the payment of the said Dividend. The withholding tax rate would vary depending on the residential status, category of the shareholder and the documents submitted by them and accepted by the Company.

All Shareholders are requested to ensure that the details such as Permanent Account Number (PAN), residential status, category of Shareholder (e.g. Domestic Company, Foreign Company, Individual, Firm, LLP, HUF, Foreign Portfolio Investors / Foreign Institutional Investors, Government, Trust, Alternate Investment Fund - Category I, II or III, etc.), email id, contact number, Bank account details and its IFSC code and address are updated, in their respective demat account(s) maintained with the Depository Participants.

If shareholder is classified as "specified person" as per the provisions of section 206AB of the Act, tax will be deducted at the rate higher of the following:

- Twice the rate specified in the relevant provision of the Income-tax Act; or
- Twice the rate or rates in force; or

- The rate of 5%.

In case of persons, whose due date for filing the Income Tax Return is July 31, 2023 or October 31, 2023, the 'specified person' means a person who has:

- not filed return of income for the previous year 2022-23 relevant to the Assessment year 2023-24; and
- subjected to tax deduction/collection at source in aggregate amounting to ₹ 50,000/- or more.

In case of persons, whose due date for filing the Income Tax Return is November 30, 2023, the 'specified person' means a person who has:

- not filed return of income for the previous year 2021-22 relevant to the Assessment year 2022-23; and
- subjected to tax deduction/collection at source in aggregate amounting to ₹ 50,000/- or more.

The specified person shall not include non-resident who does not have permanent establishment in India.

For this purpose, the Company will be relying on the information verified by the utility provided and available on the Income Tax website.

This communication summarizes the applicable TDS provisions, as per the Act, for resident and non-resident shareholders, specific categories together with documentation requirements from them to enable us to comply with the TDS related statutory obligations. The applicable rates and documentation requirements from the shareholders are tabulated below:

Shareholders having multiple accounts under different status / category:

Shareholders holding shares under multiple accounts under different status / category and single PAN, may note that, higher of the tax as applicable to the status in which shares are held under a PAN will be considered on their entire holding in different accounts.

****** The Company is not obligated to apply the beneficial Tax Treaty rates at the time of tax deduction/withholding on dividend amounts. Application of beneficial Tax Treaty Rate shall depend upon the completeness of the documents submitted by the Non-Resident shareholder and review to the satisfaction of the Company.

SUBMISSION OF TAX-RELATED DOCUMENTS: The aforesaid documents such as Form 15G/ 15H, documents under section 196, 197A, etc. can be submitted to the Company thru email at

Investors@niit.com and rta@alankit.com on or before Friday, November 10, 2023 ('Cut-off date') upto 5:00 P.M. (IST), to enable the Company to determine the appropriate TDS/withholding tax rate applicable. Any communication on the tax determination/deduction received post 5:00 P.M. (IST) of Friday, November 10, 2023 shall not be considered.

If the dividend income is taxable in the hands of any person other than the recipient of the dividend, then the requisite details by way of a declaration in **Annexure 6** should be communicated to the Company/RTA by **November 10, 2023**.

In case tax on dividend is deducted at a higher rate in the absence of receipt of the aforementioned details / documents, you would still have the option of claiming refund of the excess tax paid at the time of filing your income tax return. No claim shall lie against the Company for such taxes deducted.

If the PAN is not as per the database of the Income-tax Portal, it would be considered an invalid PAN and higher TDS, as per law, may be done.

The Securities and Exchange Board of India ("SEBI") has mandated furnishing of PAN, KYC details (i.e., Postal Address with Pin Code, email address, mobile number, bank account details) and nomination details by holders of securities. Effective from 1 January 2022, any service requests or complaints received from the Member, will not be processed by RTA till the aforesaid details/ documents are provided to RTA. On or after 1 October 2023, in case any of the above cited documents/ details are not available in the Folio(s), RTA shall be constrained to freeze such Folio(s). Members holding shares in physical form are advised to update the details as mentioned above. Relevant details and forms prescribed by SEBI in this regard are available on the website of the Company at www.niit.com

In the event of any income tax demand (including interest, penalty, etc.) arising from any misrepresentation, inaccuracy or omission of information provided / to be provided by the Member/s, such Member/s will be responsible to indemnify the Company against all claims, demands, penalties, losses etc. and also, provide the Company with all information / documents and co-operation in any appellate proceedings. No claim shall lie against the Company for such taxes deducted.

In the event of a mismatch in the category of shareholder as per the register of members and as per fourth letter of PAN, the Company would consider fourth letter of PAN for applying the surcharge rate.

We shall arrange to email a soft copy of TDS certificate to you at your registered email ID in due course, post payment of the dividend and completion of statutory formalities. In addition, to verify the tax deduction, the shareholders can also check their Form 26AS/ Annual Information Statement (AIS) from their e-filing account at [Online 26AS e-filing Website \(incometaxindia.gov.in\)](http://incometaxindia.gov.in)
