

# NASSCOM-DSCI Security Summit witnesses massive participation by stakeholders in the area of security

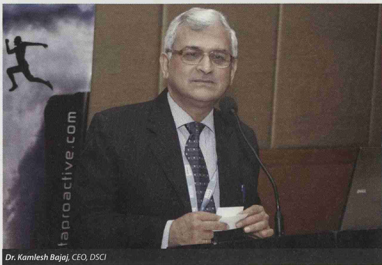
NASSCOM-DSCI 8th Annual Information Security Summit (AISS13) was inaugurated by Kapil Sibal, Minister of Communications and IT on December 11, 2013 in New Delhi. During the inaugural session, Dr. Kamlesh Bajaj, CEO, DSCI, said AISS13 has been organized to facilitate an enriching dialogue between different security communities, representing a wide variety of industry segments.
