T training firm NIIT Ltd said it plans to expand its education centres to 700 from the present 600 by 2015.

Besides the expansion, it was also upgrading all its centres as 'Cloud Campus' which would enable students to get hands-on practice through lab exercises in machine rooms and NIIT Centres, NIIT Vice-President E Venkatesan told reporters here.

NIIT Cloud Campus has an innovative 'anywhere lab' feature, which enabled

students to practice application of concepts learnt in class, from anywhere, while chatting with experts to seek answers to their queries, he said.

New Delhi, Oct. 15 Information technology solutions provider NIIT Technologies expects its business to improve in the coming quarters as the economic environment in the West it believes is improving.

"Environment in the US is improving and Euro Zone, which was a bit tough may improve in the coming months, with likely re-election of Angela Merkel as the Chancellor (of Germany)," Arvind Thakur, Chief Executive Officer and Joint Managing Director, NIIT Technologies, told reporters

The company reported a net profit of Rs 62.4 crore for the second quarter ended Septemsame period last year. Its consolidated revenue also grew 17.4 per cent year-on-year to Rs 587.3

Its headcount reduced by 190 people, and the staff strength stood at 8.017 at the end of the quarter. However, the utilisation improved to 80.3 per cent from 77.3 per cent from the previous quarter, while the attrition remained at 12.4 per cent, Thakur said.

The company also created a new position of Chief Operating Officer and inducted Sudhir Chaturvedi into the role, who will be based in the UK and will look after global sales and delivery for software and business services, Thakur added.

Its shares closed at Rs 288.50 on the BSE, down 2.89 per cent from the previous close.







The prize money of Rs 9.9 crore must have made Carlsen happy, but it was more about the pride of realizing a childhood dream.

"The monkey of not winning the world title is off my back now...I haven't yet decided how I am going to spend the prize money," a smiling Carlsen said. There was also an olive garland from the Nilgiri hills on offer, while the Fide president Kirsan Illyumzhinov presented him with a gold medal weighing 103.5 grams

Anand received the runner-up's cheque of Rs 6.03 crore along with a silver medal and a plaque.

Unlike the elaborate opening ceremony, the closing didn't take more than 15 minutes to get over. There was a Norwegian contingent expecting probably a longer event, but the organizers chose to keep it short.

Later, speaking to TOI, Anand's parents, Vishwanathan and Susheela congratulated Carlsen. "He has done a good job ... But let's not forget, Anand has proved himself five times. I don't have anything more to say, Susheela said. Viswanathan believes it's not over and his son can still stage a comeback. "Anand tried his best...Probably next time," he said.

Anand is the brand ambassador of NIIT and the institute confirmed that the Indian will continue to be a part of their family. 



Bank hiring set to surge

Calcutta, Dec. 4: Banks are looking to ramp up recruitment in the next four years to fill in the vacancies emerging out of a shortage of manpower.

Both public and private banks plan to increase their reach in rural and semi urban sectors as part of a financial inclusion programme. Industry observers point out that the RBI's grant of new licences in January will also result in significant employment opportunities in the coming years.

"About 1,50,000 jobs might be created every year for the next four years in both public as well as private sector banks," Bimal Jain, president of the Institute for Finance, Banking and Insurance (NIIT IFBI), told The Telegraph. The institute is a joint venture of NIIT and ICICI Bank and offers training for banking and finance person-

A report from consultancy firm McKinsey & Company points out that nationalised banks can face a shortage of senior management as 60-90 per cent of the deputy general managers/general managers of PSU banks are set to retire by 2016-17. A senior official of a city-based PSU bank said many lenders were looking to give early promotions to officials to make up for the loss owing to retirement. This is creating a vacuum of personnel at lower ranks.

"The PSU banks have already foreseen this and are reacting to it by hiring more people at the bottom," Jain said.

He said each PSU bank had set a target to hire about 2,000-3,000 personnel both as probationary officers and clerks every year, and the trend would persist in the next few years as well.

Jain said the IFBI was looking to train more persons to cater to the need of the

"Last year, we trained about 6,000 students and this year we expect to train about 10,000," he said. While the institution directly offers employment in private sector banks, many PSU lenders send their own selected persons to the institution for training.


