

NIT to train 10 million youth across 16 sectors

NIT Limited committed to train 100,00,000 young Indians across 16 sectors over the next five years. The aim is to skill, re-skill and up-skill Indian youth with employable skill sets across multiple sectors. NIT's Yuva Jyoti Limited – a joint venture of NIT and NSDC, has enrolled 1,550 students under the pilot phase of Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana, across three sectors – Telecom, Retail and IT in North East, Jammu & Kashmir and Jharkhand. In 2011, NIT entered into a significant public-private partnership (PPP) with National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC), to enhance skills and employability for youth across India. NIT Yuva Jyoti Limited – joint venture of NIT and NSDC (a PPP under the ministry of skill development & entrepreneurship, with 49 per cent equity held by the government of India) aims to provide skills training through over 1,500 plus centres across India.
